For Berenice International Group the privacy and security of the user's personal data are very important and therefore personal data are collected and managed with the utmost care by adopting required security.

The methods and logic of the processing personal data of users who consult the Site are described below.

The information is provided pursuant to art. 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 for all users who, interacting with the Site, provide their personal data. The validity of the information contained in this page is limited to the Site only and does not extend to other websites that may be consulted via hyperlink.

The information below, will be clearly listed:

- references to who will use personal data provided by users;
- what personal data will be used;
- the purposes and the legal basis for which the data will be used;
- the retention times and the rights that are recognized.

Users, by using this Site, accept this information and are therefore invited to read it before providing personal information of any kind.

TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this site acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of computers and terminals used by users, addresses in URI / URL (Uniform Resource Identifier / Locator) notation of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's computer environment.

These data, necessary for the use of web services, are also processed for the purpose of:

- obtaining statistical information on the use of services (most visited pages, number of visitors by time or day, geographical areas of origin, etc.);
- verifying the correct functionality of the services offered.

The navigation data do not persist for more than 60 days and are deleted immediately after their aggregation (except for any need to ascertain crimes by the judicial authorities).

Data provided voluntarily by the user

Through the Site it is possible to send requests and communications using the addresses and contact forms indicated therein. The provision of such data is mandatory and necessary to respond to requests sent as well as to contact the sender again to obtain clarifications regarding what has been reported. In particular, personal data are provided by users in order to use the services of the Site.

The Data Controller does not intentionally collect or store personal data of individuals under the age of 18, nor does it intentionally allow such minors to use the Site.

Users under the age of 18 are requested not to register on the Site and not to provide personal data.

In particular, the identification of users takes place at the time of sending requests for information / assistance and communications through the addresses and contact forms indicated on the Site. In this case, the Data Controller will process the sender's contact details necessary to reply as well as all personal data included in the communications.

PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS

The processing of personal data is carried out by the Data Controller for the following purposes:

- Responding to requests for information and assistance. The processing is functionally required to fulfill a user's request and is based on the execution of a contract or pre-contractual measures.
- To ensure the proper functioning of web pages and their contents. In this case, the data processing is based on the legitimate interest of the Data Controller.
- Use of contact details provided to send commercial communications about our products and / or services or in the interest of third parties to update users on news, promotions or offers. The treatment is based on the consent of the interested party.
- Personalization of user experience. The treatment is based on the consent of the interested party.

PROCESSING METHODS

The data will be processed with methods and procedures strictly necessary for the pursuit of the purposes for which they were collected.

In order to avoid the risk of data loss, illicit use or incorrect use of the same, unauthorized access, or alteration, suitable technological and management security measures have been adopted. Personal data will be processed by the Data Controller, by authorized personnel or by persons specifically appointed as Data Processors. At any time, the interested party can ask the Data Controller for the complete list of Managers involved in the processing of data for the purposes referred to in this document.

STORAGE

The Data Controller adheres the following policies regarding the retention of user data for the Site:

- The data provided in the contact forms or in the emails sent to the addresses published on the Site will be kept only for the time necessary to respond to the requests received.
- The navigation data will be kept for 60 days.
- The data provided for commercial communication activities will be kept until the consent of the interested party is revoked.

EXERCISE OF RIGHTS

The interested party can exercise, at any time, the rights provided for by art. 15 and ss. of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 by sending an e-mail to privacy@berenice.it. The interested party, having recourse to the conditions, also has the right to lodge a complaint with the Personal Data Protection Authority as supervisory authority, if they believe the processing of their personal data is in violation of the provisions of current legislation.
